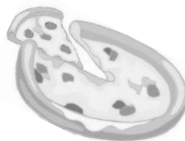
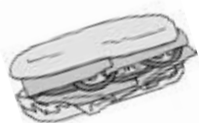

Eight-year-old **Mario Noro** was diagnosed with acute lymphoblastic leukemia, more commonly known as ALL, in early September 2011. He is receiving treatments of chemotherapy and transfusions of blood and platelets at Children's Hospital of Pittsburgh of UPMC; his treatment will last between 24 and 36 months.

Mario is the son of Jennifer and Paul Noro of Gibsonia, and he has a 6-year-old sister, Gianna. Jennifer is a school counselor in the Butler Area School District, and Paul is the building principal of Kerr Elementary in the Fox Chapel Area School District. Mario is in third grade at St Mary's School, where Gianna is in kindergarten. The family attends St. Catherine of Sweden Catholic Church in Gibsonia.

A good-natured little boy with a smile that lights up a room, Mario has a heart filled with love and a true commitment to his faith. Recently, after receiving some positive news about his blood work, he said, "See, Mom, with God, all things are possible." Because of his kind and gentle heart, in second grade, he was chosen by his peers to present flowers to the Blessed Mother at the May Crowning Ceremony last spring. He plays deck hockey for Etna Deck Hockey Association and baseball for Braun Jeffery Baseball in Shaler. He also loves to play the piano. This special blood drive has been scheduled to help replenish the community blood supply from which Mario is using. Please donate blood in honor of Mario!

Central Blood Bank is the not-for-profit organization that supplies the blood products and transfusion-related services to approximately 40 hospitals in western Pennsylvania, northern West Virginia and eastern Ohio.

Please bring ID with you on the day of the blood drive. Proper ID is required to donate blood. A Central Blood Bank or military ID, driver's license, or passport are all approved forms of ID. Birth certificate along with a picture ID that includes the donor's full name will also be accepted.
